

**33-2-21 YARD SALE REGULATION.** Any person desirous of holding a yard sale shall obtain a permit therefore from the Village Clerk. As used in this Section, the term "yard sale" shall mean any personal property sale, including garage sales, porch sales, basement sales and other similar types of sales in which individuals are selling household or personal items.

(A) **Application.** Applications for permits shall be made to the Village Clerk upon forms furnished by the Village Clerk.

(B) **Term of Permit.** Each family or individual participating in a yard sale must make application for and pay for a permit specific to the address at which the sale will take place. Any permit issued shall be for a term not exceeding **three (3) consecutive days** during each calendar year per street address participating in any yard sale (a maximum total of **four (4)** yard sales per year per address) and no sales shall be conducted on Sunday at any time. In the event of inclement weather causing the cancellation or postponement of the yard sale, the yard sale may resume on the next clear weather day. Failure to resume the yard sale on the next clear weather day will invalidate the permit and require an application for issuance of a new permit for the remaining days of the original yard sale. No charge will be made for the new permit.

(C) **Fee.** The permit for each yard sale shall be **Five Dollars (\$5.00)** per individual or family at said street address.

(D) **Permit Posted of Premises.** The permit shall be posted on the premises in a conspicuous place so as to be seen by the public and Village officials.

(E) **Hours of Sale.** Each sale shall be conducted between the hours of **6:00 A.M.** and **6:00 P.M.** only. Upon completion of each day of the yard sale, all remaining items must be removed from the yard or moved to a less conspicuous place.

(F) **Signs.** All yard sale signs shall conform to **Sections 33-2-15** and **33-3-5** of this Code.

(G) No yard sales shall generate any offensive noise, vibration, smoke, dust, odors, heat, glare, or electrical interference noticeable at or beyond the lot lines.

(H) Traffic surrounding yard sales shall abide by the Motor Vehicle Code detailed in the Village Code.
